

# Ma and Pa Family Equipment List

Updated 4/28/17

The following is a list of items that each Ma/Pa Family is responsible for providing for their family. Please try to obtain as many items as possible from what you already have on hand or by borrowing from others who already have these items. For the more expensive items such as tents, large tarps or Dutch ovens please do not purchase solely for Pioneer Trek. If you are unable to borrow these items, please contact the Stake and we will see if we can help you find these items to borrow. **BE SURE TO LABEL EVERYTHING with your LAST NAME and ASSIGNED FAMILY NUMBER!** Ma and Pa equipment, as well as individual personal buckets and sleeping gear, will be brought to the Stake Center on June 20<sup>th</sup> for loading into trailers.

The following items will be provided by the Stake in a bag for each family before boarding the bus (store in Rubbermaid container as listed below)

## Items Provided by the Stake:

- Sharpie Pen for making water bottles and other items
- Fire Ring (barrel end) with 16" stand and firewood-for warmth and family time
- Garbage bags for individual camps and to hang on handcart
- Hand Sanitizer
- Rolls of toilet paper- for needs along the trail between stops
- Matches
- Gatorade-powdered
- Candy: for eating along the trail and water bottle kill rewards
- Water bottles with Trek Logo for each member
- Kleenex
- Everything needed for meals
- Trek Journal

## Items Provided by Ma's and Pa's

- 2- 4 or 6 person lightweight tents- one for boys , one for girls
- One small tent for Ma and Pa (to go between the youth tents:)
- 2- 5 gallon insulated water jugs-igloo containers for handcart for water
- 10 x 10 Pop up shade canopy

**OR**

- 12 ft to 15 ft tarp- to cover handcart while trekking and use for shade other times
- Extendable Pole to hold up shade tarp (optional)
- Pair of leather gloves for Ma and Pa (to use for pulling handcart)
- Card table-foldable to set things on in camp (Optional)
- Small Privacy tarp, sheet or porta-pop up tent for cowboy and cowgirl stops (bathroom needs along the trail when we are not near porta-potties)
- Medium Cooler to put lunches in

## The following items will be stored in a 48-72 quart Rubbermaid or similar container

- 48-72 quart Rubbermaid storage container to put items in (be sure to write your last name on it and family number)
- Trek Devotional Book (given to you at the Ma and Pa Training meeting)
- Colored bandana (given to you in the Ma and Pa Training Meeting)
- 50 to 100 feet of rope (Sisal) or bungee cords- for tying down equipment (Sisal Rope can be purchased at Harbor Freight or other hardware store)
- Hammer
- Metal tent stakes- for tarp and tents
- Roll of Duct Tape
- Bar of soap or bottle of liquid hand soap for camp
- Small vinyl tablecloth to put on card table
- Heavy duty flashlight with extra batteries
- Pen/Pencil/ Notepad
- Wet wipes/face wipes
- Sunscreen and Lip protection with sunscreen-for those who forgot
- Bottle of hand lotion-small size
- Dish towels and wash cloths for dishes after meals

## Medical related items to be stored in a closable day-pack type bag

- Feminine hygiene items (just in case a YW forgets)
- Ziploc bags for feminine product disposal along the trail (must be put in a trash bag)
